CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Membership** – Paid up Full, Honorary & Student members for 2022/2023 season are eligible for entry.
2. **Artworks** – a) Each member may submit a maximum of **2 of the following - Framed** artworks, paintings, drawings, lino-type prints, sculptures and craft in any medium.
3. **Framing** – **All paintings must be suitably framed with ringlets (15mm or larger)** and tightly wired for hanging purposes. There is no size limitation, however larger pieces will be hung depending on the space available.
Artwork for this exhibition is not subject to selection, however, the Committee will exercise their discretion and reject paintings that may be offensive to the public.
4. **Artwork details** - an adhesive label with the Title, Artist's Name & Price should be stuck on the back of the works. Abstract pieces should be clearly marked '**This way up**' at the back.
Details on the Submitting Schedule must match the label at the back of the artwork. The PAA will not be responsible for errors.
5. **Insurance**- While every care is exercised, neither the PAA nor St. Matthew's Church accept any liability for the loss or damage to the Artworks during the setting up, duration or the taking down of the exhibition. **Artists are strongly advised to have their own insurance.**
6. **Submission** – Artworks should be delivered free of wrapping, to St. Matthew's Church, on **Friday 19th May, between 11.00am & 1.00pm**
7. All sold Artworks are subject to 20% commission. No commission on cards sold.
8. **Submission Fees** – **All Artwork - £4.00 per piece.**

Cards - £1.00 per pack of 10 or less in a pack

- a. Please ensure that all card packs are price labelled.**
- b. All single cards are individually price labelled.**

9. Collection of unsold Artworks – Tuesday 23rd May between 3-5pm
